### New Business

1. Daffodil Road Project A hearing was held on Weds. and \$125,000 was awarded, but is subject to appeal by the City or by Adobe Wells. Our lawyer intends to appeal. 2. Report from Rules & Regulations Committee The Committee of 3 has been working on reviewing and adding to existing rules. Revision is subject to attorney review and will be voted on by homeowners. 3. Landscaping Request Current budget is \$3,000 per year. Request was made for an additional \$1,000 per year. 4. North-side Post Office concrete is in bad shape. We are currently getting estimates to put down non-slip tile, which would be considered a Maintenance Expense. 5. January Board Meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 3rd at 9 am. Employees are off on Monday. 6. 2023 General Budget A budget meeting will be held on Friday. January 13th from 1 to 2:30 pm where homeowners can ask questions about the budget before we vote on it.



The early morning chair exercise group continues to meet Mon. & Weds. at 8 am in Wertz Hall.




