- City of McAllen's Special Commissioners Award on the Daffodil Project Since we were unaware of a Status Hearing that took place February 9th, after short notice and a plea for Adobe residents to appear at the courthouse February 13th, the Judge, impressed with the impressive turnout, proceeded with the preliminary hearing. - 4. North Side Post Office The contractor hired to tear up and replace the existing concrete is injured, so the Board is looking for a new contractor.






